



SKATE PARK RULES

Please use this park safely and responsibly.

- Skate Park is open from dawn until skate area lighting is turned off, or until dusk; whichever shall come last, as scheduled by the City of Menifee.
- Use of this unsupervised skateboarding area is at your own risk.
- External, foreign skate obstacles are prohibited.
- Dogs and all other pets are prohibited from entering the Skate Park.
- Motorized vehicles are not allowed in the Skate Park.
- Fireworks, firearms or weapons (including toy replicas) of any type are prohibited.
- Smoking and consumption of tobacco, alcohol, or other controlled substances is prohibited.
- Littering, tagging, graffiti, polluting, and dumping are prohibited. Please keep your park clean and dispose of trash and debris in the designated receptacles. No glass containers are permitted in the skateboarding area
- Park users shall not produce loud and unreasonable noise, including, playing music, using amplification equipment or playing a musical instrument, which disturbs, injures or endangers the health or peace of others.
- Skate Park is for skateboarding, in-line skating, and hard wheel scooters only. Bicycles and BMX use is prohibited.
- Helmets must be worn at all times. Elbow pads and knee pads are highly recommended.
- Every person under the age of fourteen must be supervised by an adult.
- Skating on the curbs, sidewalks, fences, railings and/or driveways of the City owned area surrounding the skateboarding area is prohibited.
- If you observe a serious violation of these rules including vandalism, please report the incident immediately to the City of Menifee Police Department at (951) 776-1099. Violators will be prosecuted.
