


### Intermittent closures for ramp and bridge construction at Newport Road

#### Construction Activities Suspended in observance of the Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday

In observance of the Holiday, construction work will be suspended Friday-Monday, January 13-16, 2017. Construction activities will resume on Tuesday, January 17, 2017.

### Newport Road Interchange Nears Completion

Crews have completed joining both sides of the Newport Road Bridge and have opened all on- and off-ramps to the public. Continued work has been shifted to completing the new southbound and northbound lanes underneath the Newport Road Bridge and for preparation of landscaping.

For the safety of the crews and the traveling public, intermittent ramp and lane closures will continue to facilitate preparations for re-striping of the mainline, and removal of concrete barrier rail (k-rail).

Please plan ahead in anticipation of the temporary increased traffic in this area. If possible, please avoid the project corridor and use an alternate route. Motorists and pedestrians should slow down and use caution when traveling through work zones, near barricades and equipment.
