This 4 hour course teaches Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), and relief of Foreign Body Airway Obstruction (FBAO) for adult, child, and infant victims. Upon successful completion of this course you will receive a certificate (AHA Heartsaver CPR card) for Adult CPR/AED valid for two (2) years.

Basic Life Support (BLS) training reinforces healthcare professionals' understanding of the importance of early CPR and defibrillation, basic steps of performing CPR, relieving choking, and using an AED; and the role of each link in the Chain of Survival. Students work with an AHA BLS Instructor to complete BLS skills practice and skills testing. Students also complete a written exam.
