City of Menifee Reminds Residents of Consolidated Primary Election

MENIFEE – Approximately 964,000 voter information guides started going out to Riverside County voters on April 26th for the consolidated primary election on June 5, 2018. Material in the voter information guide will help voters make informed choices. The Menifee City Clerk/Elections Official, recommends that voters review the materials before casting an official ballot, and if voters do not receive an information guide in the mail, it is available online at www.voteinfo.net or voters may call the registrar’s office at (951) 486-7200 or (800) 773-8683 to request a mailed copy.

If a registered voter would like to **“drop off” their Vote-By-Mail ballot early**, up until the Election Day, they may do so at the **Menifee City Hall** or the Registrar of Voters, to name just a few locations. Menifee City Hall is located at 29714 Haun Road, Menifee, CA, and is open from 8 am-5pm. Ballots must be received at the Registrar of Voters office or any Riverside County polling place by 8 PM on Election Day, or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day to be counted.

Registered voters in all areas of the county are eligible to cast votes in this election. For questions about your eligibility to vote, contact the registrar’s office at (951) 486-7200. Voter polling-place locations are printed on the back cover of the information guide, which includes an application to request a vote-by-mail ballot. A Spanish-language version of the guide will be available at www.voteinfo.net and a copy can be mailed upon request. If you want to register, update your address or change your political party preference you must complete a voter registration application and submit it by May 21. You can register online at www.registertovote.ca.gov or request a paper application by calling (951) 486-7200.

The Menifee City Clerk’s office reminds residents that the June 5 election is a countywide election, and that the City does not endorse or support any candidate. The City Seal shall also not be used on any graphics or materials produced by any candidate, business or others as it is the registered seal of the City for official City business.
