Menifee, CA– The City of Menifee will host a ribbon cutting event at the newly renamed John V. Denver Park located at 28050 Encanto Drive on Oct. 2 at 3 p.m. Oct. 2 has also been proclaimed Clean Air Day by the City Council, which will be commemorated with a tree planting at the park after the ribbon cutting. New exercise equipment that was donated by the Rotary Club of Menifee will also be unveiled at the event.

John V. Denver is a past City Council member who served on the Council during the City's first 10 years after incorporation. He also worked on the City's incorporation efforts prior to official incorporation in 2008.
