**I. Call to Order**

The meeting, which was held at Kay Cenicerros Senior Center, 29995 Evans Road, Menifee, CA, was called to order at 6:00p.m. by Mark Cooper, Chair.

**III. Current Topics of Discussion**

*a. Overview and Discussion of the Brown Act*

Rob Johnson represented the City of Menifee. As the first order of business, Rob explained to members the rules and guidelines that we must follow under the Brown Act. Marty Rosen expressed concern that members might give the appearance of violation, when in fact having a discussion unrelated to issues.

*b. Update on Census Information*

Members reported on their activities during past two weeks to promote Census 2010. Some have arranged for locations and banners to be placed. Phoebe Irej experienced positive results with the school boards that she contacted. Perris Union superintendent stated that they need make only one recorded plea and then dial one number to send it automatically to each student's parents by phone, in both English and Spanish.

*c. Discussion and Scheduling of Next Meeting*

It was decided that future meetings will be held on Mondays nights at City Hall, 29714 Haun Road; the frequency of meetings is to be determined at a later date, but while Census 2010 is the focus, the committee will continue to meet bi-weekly.

The minutes of the first meeting were read and approved.

Under the Brown Act, all meetings are open to the public, and attendees will have the right to comment. Further discussion revolved around the scope and area of our involvement with matters of concern that we may hear voiced by citizens, and whether we would answer questions posed by the public. Rob Johnson informed us that our direction will be determined by the City Council, and that the public will be notified of the meetings in the same way that they are notified of City Council meetings.

It was moved and seconded that our next meeting be March 22. The meeting was adjourned at 6:54 p.m.
