

**City of Menifee Public Safety Committee
Meeting Minutes
June 22, 2010**

1. Call to order

Chairman John Denver called the meeting to order at 4:10 p.m. Present were: Chairman John Denver, Committee member Scott Mann, City Manager Steve Harding, Community Development Director Carmen Cave, Senior Code Enforcement Officer Wayne O'Gara, Emergency Services Michael Anderson, Lt. Dan Feltenberger, City Clerk Kathy Bennett, one member of public (Jim Rothgeb – Californian), and Becky Elam of Mt. San Jacinto Community College Business Services.

2. Public Comments

3. Approval of Minutes of Public Safety Committee Meeting of May 10, 2010

Approved by Committee.

4. Discussion regarding potential Sheriff Substation at the Mt. San Jacinto College Menifee Campus

Chairman Denver noted he asked for this item to be on the agenda following a discussion with the President of the college, Roger Schultz. He stated an opportunity arose where the City might place a police substation on the campus in trade for patrolling the campus. Councilmember Mann clarified that it would be a possible store front but not a substation and that was confirmed by Lt. Feltenberger in a description of the type of facility needed. Following discussion of the various possibilities, the committee asked the City Manager to research possible alternative in conjunction with the request from last year to consider option for policing for the city and how this might fit with those options. The City Manager agreed to research those items and return them to the committee and Council.

6. Final Administrative Policy for Neighborhood Watch Program

Chairman Denver stated this is a clear plan and asked Emergency Services coordinator Mike Anderson to update the committee. Mr. Anderson gave the committee an update on the policy. The committee asked if the policy could be reviewed by the City Manager and asked for an update to the Council on an upcoming agenda. Chairman Denver asked if the emergency services Coordinator could update the committee on the emergency plan as it is developed.

7. Code Enforcement Updates

Director Cave distributed the new postcard that announces the new Animal Control services for the City of Menifee. The committee asked if a press release could be sent

on this matter. She noted there is a great deal of activity with bees that are being responded to by the Code Enforcement Department.

8. Committee Members Comments

Chairman Denver asked for update on the Sun City Fire station location possibilities; discussion of crime watch programs for future; and an update on emergency services development of City emergency plan progress. Committee member Mann asked for consideration of the City Manager on the way the agenda is structured and suggestions for improvement.

9. City Manager Comments

- Jessica's Law and possible ordinance to strengthen – waiting on court decision for case law finding
- Discussion of possibility of Mt. San Jacinto Community College station or store front Police department including the consideration of a future policing recommendation and how that would work with a station consideration
- Sun City Fire Station recommendations discussion – City Manager to meet with Fire representatives and schedule to discuss with Public Safety after August 1, 2010.
- Consideration of the future of Crime Watch for the City
