2013 NEEDS ASSSMENT SURVEY REPORT

To help identify the needs of the thousands of senior residents within the Menifee Community, the City of Menifee Ad-Hoc Committee for Menifee Senior Residents conducted a Needs Assessment Survey. Significant efforts to reach as many senior residents as possible were done. A total of three hundred fifty-two (352) survey results were received. The results from the returned surveys have been compiled and summarized into this report.



Needs Assessment Survey

Comprehensive Summary of Needs Assessment Survey Results

A total of 352 surveys were received in response to the Needs Assessment Survey conducted in 2013. In total, this represents approximately 1.55% of the total Menifee senior citizen population, including all 55+ residents. By conducting this survey, the Ad-Hoc Committee for Menifee Senior Citizens was able to start to get a sense of what the major concerns/issues are for the senior residents of Menifee.


The following were the main issues/common topics identified through the survey results:





Overwhelmingly, transportation was identified as the most important issue/concern by survey respondents. Accessibility to and from the doctor's offices, retail, and amenities were identified as very important.

While a majority of survey respondents (304 of 352, 86%) indicated they drive, augmenting existing transportation options was a need identified throughout various survey questions (Survey Questions #4, #8, #16, 17).



Social and Recreational Opportunities

In general, survey results indicated interest in expanding social and recreational opportunities. Over 55% (Survey Question #5) of survey respondents indicated they currently volunteer (with volunteering ranging from HOAs to hospitals to the library), and another 22% indicating they plan to volunteer in the future. "Additional recreational opportunities", "cultural/recreational/social opportunities" were identified as needs/additional assistance in other survey questions (Survey Questions #4, and 16), indicating the survey's respondents interest in participating in social and recreational opportunities.



While the primary form of communication for survey respondents was identified as "Word of Mouth", the second most used resource was Menifee E-News. Other primary sources of information include the newspaper, senior center, and City of Menifee website. These responses help establish that while many senior residents still rely on traditional mediums of communication (newspaper, radio), many are also using newer communication tools like e-news. Other survey questions, such as Survey Question #7 and #8, identified senior specific websites, increasing computer literacy, and direct email to seniors, as

methods to improve information distibution and access to services for senior residents. Computer Use and/or internet access, was the most popular response when asked what senior resident most need assistance with (Survey Question #16), further signaling the interest in using new communication methods.

❖ Favorite Things about Menifee



The "quiet ambiance", "location/proximity to amenities and/or family" and the "small town feel" were the top three things identified by survey respondents as what they liked most about Menifee. Other related responses, such as "small town feel", "friendly people/overall community" and "senior community", indicating that while the geographical composition and weather are important factors, it is the personal relationship and people that make the senior community enjoy living in Menifee (Survey Question #3).

Directory/Resources Guide



The idea of a senior services directory/resources guide was positively received by survey respondents; over 78% (Survey Question #9) responded a directory of senior services and opportunities would be beneficial.


2010 US CENSUS DATA DEMOGRAPHICS




City of Menifee 55+ Years of Age Population (2010 US Census)









Reside in which specific Menifee Community (Survey Question: #1)







Rent/Own in age-restricted area of Menifee (Survey Question: About You)











Don't drive, transportation for errands appointments, etc are: (Survey Question: #13)






